DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Read **Revelation 5**. What points or applications from the sermon particularly resonated with you? What questions do you have from the passages that were preached?

3. Knowing that God succeeds in accomplishing His vision, how does this influence your courage and boldness to share Jesus with others?
4. Read **Matthew 9:35-38**. When Jesus saw the crowds, what was His response? Why do you think He had this kind of response?
5. When you think about Jesus knowing that some within this crowd would be a part of the same crowd that crucified Him, how does that influence the way you think about His love towards sinners?
6. How can we develop that same kind of compassion towards those who are close to us but far from God?
7. Read **2 Corinthians 5:14-21**. Why is identity such a big part in changing our behavior?
