DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Read **Matthew 28:16-20**. What points or applications from the sermon particularly resonated with you? What questions do you have from the passages that were preached?
2. Why do you think Matthew includes the issue of some disciples doubting Jesus? What does Jesus say to help them overcome this doubt? Why is that important for us today?
3. It's easy to pass off our responsibility to make disciples to the "professionals" (pastors/elders/missionaries, etc.). What changes do we need to make in our thinking that will help us recapture our responsibility to fulfill the Great Commission?
4. In verse 20, Jesus assures His disciples that He will be with them always, even to the end of the age. How does the knowledge of Christ's abiding presence affect your faith and willingness to engage in His mission?
5. What are some challenges and opportunities you see in today's world for spreading the Gospel and making disciples? How can the church adapt to these challenges and make the most of these opportunities?
